

**ThingLink Documents Project – Due \_\_\_\_\_**

With one partner, you will be analyzing part of a founding United States Document and creating a project using the ThingLink tool. ThingLink is a tool that allows you to create a rich, interactive experience with an image. Your audience is the 11<sup>th</sup> grade US History classes. They need a quick way to review the founding documents they learned about in Civics and Economics to help them be more successful in US History. Requirements:

- Link to a site or article that illustrates how the document informs something happening today. Look for current events on news sites. A good place to start is news.google.com. You should explain how your site or article is connected to the document. (15 points)
- Embed at least two videos that are each 3 minutes or less and related to the document. (15 points each – 30 points total)
- Write text boxes to annotate 3 parts of the document. In your annotations, you should fully explain a portion or concept within the document. Be as specific as possible. (15 points each – 45 points total)
- Be creative and complete the project on time (10 points)
